DOWNTOWN HOMES TOUR IS HERE!

Ticket sales are well underway for the City People Downtown Homes Tour on Saturday, September 29 from 1 – 6 p.m. Living spaces in many historic and unique buildings will be featured on the tour, including The Atelier, The Burwell, The Cherokee, Commerce Bldg., Crown Court, FireStreet Lofts, Gallery Lofts, Gay St. residences, Hewgley Park, Lerner Lofts, Market Square residences, and The Pembroke. On Sunday, September 30 from 1 – 4 p.m., new properties that are for sale and currently undergoing renovation will be available to tour using the same ticket – a great way to see what will soon be available downtown!

The walking tour is self-guided and self-paced, with many stores and restaurants open and available along the way. Free parking is available at State and Locust Street Garages. Tickets may be purchased prior to the event at Vagabondia (Market Square), Bliss on Market Square, and the Saturday Market Square Farmers' Market each Saturday from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. On the day of the event, tickets must be purchased at Downtown Grill & Brewery (424 South Gay Street, Woodruff Building) starting at 11 a.m. Discounted pre-purchased tickets are \$10, and on the day of the event tickets are \$15 for one, or two for \$20. All tour participants should pick up a tour map on the day of the event at Downtown Grill & Brewery.



Volunteers are needed to help staff homes during the tour. Every volunteer is given a complimentary pass to go on the tour after they are done. There will also be a celebration at Sapphire after the tour for volunteers and for homeowners on the tour.
